2011 Chap 58 (2SHB 1362)

The original act.

2011 S.SL Chap 4 (SSB 5988)

Established immunity for non-lawyer mediators and limits to discovery or compulsory process.

2012 Chap 185 (ESHB 2614)

Established experience/training requirements for mediators. Modified timelines for provision of documents, notifying, scheduling and convening of mediation. Allows for extensions by agreement.

2014 Chap 164 (HB 2723)

Expanded definition of borrower to include spouse awarded title and occupying successor-in-interest to deceased borrower. Provides for voluntary mediation.

2018 Chap 3016 (2ESHB 2057, eff. 6/7/2018)

Changes to agency funding allocation and required beneficiary remittances.
